**Dress Standards**

The following goals and guidelines related to dress are in place to create at Rogers a safe environment conducive to learning and Christian character development. It is the parent's responsibility to make sure the child comes to school appropriately dressed. When a child comes to school inappropriately dressed, the parents will be called to assist the child in changing.

**Goal 1: We will be known for modesty.**

- Shorts may be worn if they are mid-thigh length or longer.
- Dresses and skirts should reach the top of the knee.
- Sheer, tight, revealing, or see-through clothing is not permitted.
- Shirts and tops should be long enough to keep the midriff covered at all times.
- Sleeveless shirts/blouses are not allowed.
- Necklines and backlines should be modestly cut. Shirts/blouses should be worn buttoned, except for the top button.
- Only modestly-cut one-piece bathing suits are acceptable.

**Goal 2: We will keep the learning environment free of distractions.**

- Hats and other head covering should not be worn in the building.
- Extreme or faddish hairstyles or fashions are not allowed.
- Hair colors and patterns should be natural in appearance.
- Aside from the school name and small clothing company logos and/or monograms in the shirt pocket area, no other writing is allowed on clothing. Only graphics such as nature scenes, animal prints, and color patterns are acceptable.
- Jewelry, sunglasses, excessive makeup, face or hair glitter or paint, body stickers, and tattoos are not allowed.

**Goal 3: We will be safe.**

- Shoes and socks that cover and protect the entire foot should be worn at PE and on the playground.
- Accessories, hairstyles, clothing, or color combinations that are associated with gangs, hate groups, or other inappropriate subcultures are not allowed.

**Goal 4: We will look sharp.**

- All clothing should be neat, clean, well-fitted, and in good repair.
- Long shirts or shirts with tails will be worn tucked in.
- Oversized clothing is not allowed.
- Underwear should remain covered at all times.
- A code-approved shirt must be worn under all outerwear.
